

Washington Beech HOPE VI

The Resident Advisory Committee has been exploring the possibility of creating some "Smoke-Free" housing at the new Washington Beech. One or more buildings may be designated "Smoke-Free" meaning that no one would be permitted to smoke inside or near those buildings. A Smoke-Free policy is NOT discriminatory. Smokers are not excluded from the building. They are simply being told to smoke outside.

The accompanying fact sheet presents the reasons why a Smoke-Free policy could benefit the Washington Beech community. We intend to explore the idea further at a community meeting in the coming weeks.
